

How is a Credit Union Different than a Bank?

Credit Union

- Not-for-Profit Income is returned to members in higher dividends, low or no cost services, and lower loan rates.
- Member Owned Every member is an equal owner of Estacado FCU and gets one vote.
- 3. **Tax-Exempt** As a not-for-profit, credit unions do not pay federal and state taxes, therefore returning income to members.
- Credit unions are cooperative -Over 5,000 credit unions nationwide work together to encourage responsible savings and borrowing.
- 5. Credit Unions may not be sold because they are member owned.
- 6. **Unpaid Boards** Boards are unpaid volunteers selected by their fellow members. Members of all savings balances may run for the Board each year.



Bank

- For Profit Company must make enough profit to pay out of area stockholders a dividend.
- 2. **Stock Owned** Owned by someone who may not use the bank and often lives out of state.
- 3. **Taxed** Many banks pay tax on their much higher average income due to larger fees collected from their customers.
- Highly competitive banks work against each other and often aggressively buy out their competitors to limit adversaries and close branches in small towns.
- Banks can be sold banks have stocks and may be bought or sold without the consent of their customers.
- Boards Bank Boards generally consist of only large, very rich stockholders who get voted onto Board and get paid.
